

Chest Seal



What is a chest seal?

 A clear bandage with strong glue used for chest wounds









Use a Chest Seal on a chest wound

Air: If you <u>hear</u> air.

Bubbles: If you <u>see</u> or <u>hear</u> bubbles.

Chest seal

Remember that injuries to the body:

- Can be on the front, back, or sides of the chest.
- May have more than one opening in the chest if due to gunshots.

Steps to apply a chest seal

- 1. Dry the skin if possible around the wound.
- 2. Center the sticky side down over the wound (i.e. hole).
- 3. Apply and press the chest seal to the skin.


